

Application and Enrollment Checklist

The International Student Application occurs in a Rolling Admissions Cycle. Once an application is received we aim to complete your package (interview, testing, and receipt of transcripts and scores) and provide an admissions decision via email within a month. Admission to our school is a selective and competitive process.

<input type="radio"/> Apply online at brooklyn.basisindependent.com (click "Apply Now") and pay the application fee of \$200. (Please note: International applicants who need an F-1 Student Visa must select the "International Student Admission Cycle" on the application form.)	
<input type="radio"/> Submit school transcripts of the last three years via email: brooklyn-isp@basisindependent.com	
<input type="radio"/> Send official TOEFL score report from ETS using the institution codes C243 (required score: 80; preferred score: 90+). Please ensure C243 is listed as your "Designated Score Recipient".	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please note: Upon receipt of the application and the required documents, the school admissions team will reach out to you via email to schedule the following interview and assessments. 	
<input type="radio"/> Schedule and complete a one-hour web-interview with an Admissions Staff Member that includes a reading and writing assessment.	
<input type="radio"/> Schedule and complete a one-hour proctored web-math assessment.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Optional Materials: We welcome any additional standardized test scores (EIKEN, UL SSAT, ISEE, IELTS:6.5, iTEP/SLATE:6) that support your child's candidacy 	n/a

<input type="radio"/> Accept your seat by completing the following steps within three weeks after being accepted: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete the enclosed enrollment agreement • Pay a non-refundable deposit by wire transfer • Submit a copy of proof of funds 	
<input type="radio"/> Receive a Form I-20 from the school and apply for an F-1 student visa at the U.S. Embassy (Please note: a Form I-20 will only be issued after the enrollment agreement, deposit, and proof of funds have been received.)	
<input type="radio"/> Pay the full amount of tuition by wire transfer by May 1st, 2019	
<input type="radio"/> Complete the medical forms

<input type="radio"/> Prepare for school by reading the recommended list of books or any additional supplementary materials provided by the school
