

## **Application and Enrollment Checklist**

The International Student Application occurs in a Rolling Admissions Cycle. Once an application is received we aim to complete your package (interview, testing, and receipt of transcripts and scores) and provide an admissions decision via email within a month. Admission to our school is a selective and competitive process.

Below are all of the steps required to apply and attend BASIS Independent Fremont:

0	Apply online at siliconvalley.basisindependent.com (click "Apply Now") and pay the application fee of \$200. (Please note: International applicants who need an F-1 Student Visa must select the "International Student Admission Cycle" on the application form.)	
0	Submit school transcripts of the last three years via email: fremont-isp@basisindependent.com	
0	Send official TOEFL Primary score report from ETS using the institution codes C244. Please ensure C244 is listed as your "Designated Score Recipient".	
•	Please note: Upon receipt of the application and the required documents, the school admissions team will reach out to you via email to schedule the following interview and assessments.	
0	Schedule and complete a web-interview with an Admissions Staff Member that includes a reading and writing assessment.	
0	Schedule and complete a proctored web-math assessment.

<ul> <li>Receive a Form I-20 from the school and apply for an F-1 student visa at the U.S. Embassy (Please note: a Form I-20 will only be issued after the enrollment agreement, deposit, and proof of funds have been received.)</li> </ul>

O Complete the medical forms

O Prepare for school by reading the recommended list of books or any additional supplementary materials provided by the school
