Once an application is received, we aim to complete your package (interview, testing, and receipt of transcripts and scores) and provide an admissions decision via email within a month. 0	Apply online at mclean.basisindependent.com (click "Apply Now") and pay the application fee of \$200. (Please note: International applicants who need an F-1 Student Visa must select the "International Student Admission Cycle" on the application form.)	
0	Submit school transcripts of the last three years via email: mclean-admissions@basisindependent.com	
0	Send official TOEFL score report from ETS using the institution codes B925. Please ensure B925 is listed as your "Designated Score Recipient".	
•	Please note: Upon receipt of the application and the required documents, the school admissions team will reach out to you via email to schedule the assessments and interview.	
0	Schedule and complete a proctored web-based assessment.	
0	Schedule and complete a web-interview with an Admissions Staff Member that includes a reading and writing assessment.

	Receive a Form I-20 from the school and apply for an F-1 student visa at the U.S. Embassy (Please note: A Form I-20 will only be issued after the enrollment agreement, deposit, and proof of funds have been received.)	
0	Pay the full amount of tuition by wire transfer by May 1, 2022
