

Application Checklist: Grades 1 and 2

ROLLING ADMISSIONS DEADLINES

Application Completion Deadline: Applications for all grades are open until the grade has closed. Once a grade has closed, submitted applications that are eligible for acceptance will automatically go into our waiting pool.

Admissions Notifications: Within 10 business days of completing your application, after March 3.

Enrollment Agreement and Deposit Deadline: Within 15 business days of being offered a seat.
