Below are the steps required to apply and, if accepted, enroll at BASIS Independent Brooklyn:

<input type="radio"/> Apply online at brooklyn.basisindependent.com (click “Apply Now”) and pay the application fee of \$200. (Please note: International applicants who need an F-1 Student Visa must select the “International Student Admission Cycle” on the application form.)	
<input type="radio"/> Submit school transcripts of the last three years via email: brooklyn-isp@basisindependent.com	
<input type="radio"/> Send official TOEFL score report from ETS using the institution code: C243. Please ensure C243 is listed as your “Designated Score Recipient”.	
<input type="radio"/> Request math and English teacher recommendations through the application portal.	
<input type="radio"/> Schedule and complete a virtual Family Meeting with an Admissions team member.	
<input type="radio"/> Schedule and complete a proctored virtual Entrance Exam

<input type="radio"/> Accept your seat by completing the following steps within three weeks after being accepted: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete the enclosed enrollment agreement • Pay a non-refundable deposit by wire transfer • Submit a copy of proof of funds 	
<input type="radio"/> Receive a Form I-20 from the school and apply for an F-1 student visa at the U.S. Embassy <i>Please note: a Form I-20 will only be issued after the enrollment agreement, deposit, and proof of funds have been received.</i>	
<input type="radio"/> Pay the full amount of tuition by wire transfer by May 1, 2025	
<input type="radio"/> Complete the medical forms	
<input type="radio"/> Arrange your Homestay through an accredited SEVIS Homestay Agency (if needed)	
<input type="radio"/> Prepare for school by reading the recommended list of books or any additional supplementary materials provided by the school
