

The International Student Program application process occurs in a Rolling Admissions Cycle. Admissions to BASIS Independent Silicon Valley is a multi-step, selective, and competitive process. Below are the steps required to apply and, if accepted, enroll at BASIS Independent Silicon Valley:

CHECKLIST FOR APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Apply online at siliconvalley.basisindependent.com (click “Apply Now”) and pay the application fee of \$200. (Please note: International applicants who need an F-1 Student Visa must select the “International Student Admission Cycle” on the application form).
- Submit school transcripts of the last three years via email: siliconvalley-isp@basisindependent.com
- Send official TOEFL score report from ETS using the institution code: C244. Please ensure C244 is listed as your “Designated Score Recipient”.
- Schedule and complete an in-person or virtual interview with a member of the Admissions Team. This interview will include a reading and writing assessment.
- Schedule and complete a proctored in-person or virtual math assessment.

CHECKLIST FOR ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Accept your seat by completing the following steps:
 - Submit the signed ISP Enrollment Agreement
 - Pay a non-refundable deposit by wire transfer
 - Submit a copy of proof of funds
- Submit the completed medical forms.
- Pay the full amount of tuition by wire transfer.
- Receive a Form I-20 from the school and apply for an F-1 student visa at the U.S. Embassy
- Arrange your Homestay through an accredited SEVIS Homestay Agency (if needed).
