Commitment deadline by grade: PreK: March 6, 2025; Kindergarten: February 13, 2025; Grades 1-8: March 3, 2025;

Grades 9-10: March 12, 2025

- 1 | When can I schedule the required meetings? The Play Date or Entrance Exam and Family Meeting can be scheduled on your application portal.
- 2 | Is my child required to attend the Family Meeting? K—Grade 1 applicants are required to attend the play date/family meeting. Applicants applying to Grade 2 and above are required to attend the family meeting.
- 3 Can I send you copies of my child's transcripts? In the application there is a Transcript Release Form to submit to your student's school, who will then send official transcripts directly to Admissions.
- 4 My child has only one teacher for both English and math; what is the requirement? Please have your student's teacher fill out both the English and math recommendation forms.
